Saturday 12th September.

The following arrangements have been made and members are urged to take careful note in the interest of safety.

On Saturday 12th Sept, all members are kindly requested to stop all flying and to vacate the flying site by latest 4pm

Members are requested to cooperate with the event organizers who on Saturday are authorized to temporarily remove three concrete blocks from the runway perimeter fence, SW corner to allow direct access to the runway.

A temporary barrier shall be erected instead to allow continued use of the runway during the day.

Last members to leave on these days are kindly reminded to ensure that clubhouse facilities and GATE are locked .

The committee is taking all possible precautions in conjunction with the event organizers and the Office of the President to ensure that no damage occurs to our facilities.
